- Hospital - original Maldon Hospital
- Lake Cairn Curran and Loddon river
- Lisle's Gully walk
- Maldon Cemetery
- Maldon Court House
- Maldon Gaol

- Mount Tarrangower and the lookout tower
- North British Mine walk
